The facility expansion added 12,700 square feet of new space, including additional cleanroom capacity, offices, labs, machine shop, break room, restrooms, and additional parking.

Travis Sessions, CEO of Biomerics, remarked, "The expansion in Texas is a direct result of the growth of the business.
